Laing O'Rourke has been using CCG glands in industrial projects in Australia for 10-15 yrs now. We first moved to CCG because of the encapsulated cone technology; allowing the gland to be unscrewed without losing the parts of the gland. At the end of a project you didn't have to throw out all of the glands with missing cones, as with other gland manufactures.

A considerable cost saving on larger projects.

With Laing O'Rourke's involvement with the Oil and Gas industry, we continue to use CCG glands with an emphasis on the E1EX series including QuickstopEx resin injection barrier glands.
